

The Board of Selectmen held a meeting on Tuesday Feb. 14, 2012 at the Dalton Municipal Building, Dalton, NH.

PRESENT: Selectman St.Cyr, Selectman Whittum and Chairman Crosby (on speaker phone)

Motion - *by Selectman St.Cyr to accept the minutes for Feb. 7, 2012 as posted*

Second - *by Selectman Whittum*

Vote - 3-0-0

Selectmen - reviewed paperwork received from North Country Council regarding brownfields. Selectman Whittum will review the paperwork and the Board will pass it on to the Conservation Commission and the Planning Board. Sandy York will speak with North Country Council for more details.

Motion: *by Selectman St.Cyr to take the brownfield issue under advisement and check on the impact it would have on property owners.*

Vote: 3-0-0

Selectmen - Reviewed bids on a key pass system for the municipal building. Capital Alarm has the better deal. Sandy York will speak with Capital Alarm about any difference in the price quote to add the door at the end of the hall by the library.

Motion: *by Selectman St.Cyr to accept the bid from Capital Alarm providing the costs for the extra door keeps the bid under \$2,000.*

Second: *by Selectman Whittum*

Vote: 3-0-0

Selectmen - Signed the contract with LaFlamme's for cemetery maintenance.

Selectman St.Cyr - Questioned if there were any new quotes from Bob Wentworth on a loader.

Sandy York - Team O' Neil would like to meet with the Board regarding a road rally in Sept.

Selectmen - Schedule them for the meeting after town meeting.

Selectman St.Cyr - Selectman Whittum is doing a good job and being very helpful.

Sandy York - We will probably have to schedule a hearing on the new loader as it is a bond issue for over \$100,000.
