Maggie Michaud - The Recreation Department would like to set up a time for interviews with the applicants for the summer recreation program.

Select Board - scheduled May 29th at 5 pm.

Maggie Michaud - We are set with the dance on June 23rd from 7 to 10 pm and a police officer will be there. If it works out we would like to do more. Pat Beck from LGC said we can hire people for 40 hours a week and not pay benefits if it is a temporary position. I would like a key to the building for the Recreation Department. Angela Blanchette would be my Alternate. We are going to have children from Dalton and out of town in the program. Dalton children will pay less. We will need 17 children to support the program. Twin Mt will be sharing all their forms with us.

Chairman St.Cyr - Would like to see them in the minutes.

Chairman St.Cyr - The road crew has done a good job here with the digging and stones around the building.

Shawn St.Cyr - Discussed the pump situation at the pump house with the Board. He needs to check the panel and he will do that on his own time. He will ask Buddy Ball to help him.

Maggie Michaud - Requested a key to the municipal building for the State Library and one for the Library Trustee.

Select Board Simonds - You are a library trustee and can use the key we issued you as the Recreation Director.

Select Board - approved issuing a key to the State Library. They will have to come in and sign for it.

Chairman St.Cyr - Wonders if the town should put up signs on the old Gilman bridge. Is it safe for bikers and walkers.

Select Board Member Whittum - If we don't own it we shouldn't put signs up.

Sandy York - will investigate the ownership of the bridge.
