

Meeting opened at 5:30 pm

Select Board - would like to have a monthly meeting with department heads.

Chairman St.Cyr - informed Bruce Walsh that we are closely monitoring the demo debris at the transfer to see if we are charging enough money to cover costs. We might have to increase some of our charges.

Bruce Walsh - Rob Blanchette is working with me on recycling and how things are priced.

Chief Audit - Things at Forest Lake are going good. We close up between 9 and 9:30.

Chairman St.Cyr - We have not heard anything bad.

Sandy York - Received a couple of good comments on the town helping to keep the park open

Chief Audit - The radar trailer will be here next week in town. There has been an attempt for fraud on the phone.

Chairman St.Cyr - We would like to see a police report in the paper.

Chief Audit - People need to watch out for mail thefts, especially prescription drugs and checks.

Select Board Member Simonds - Controlled drugs have to be singled for. On Wednesday I picked up mail on the ground by the dump.

Ron Sheltry - We have had 55 calls this year. Our cabinet system has arrived and looks excellent. The new rig is in at North Country Ford. They will prep it tomorrow and we can pick it up on Wednesday.

Select Board Member Whittum - If there is any money left we should get a heavy duty tent.

Ron Sheltry - Explained an extended warranty and doesn't think we should do it.

Chairman St.Cyr - We will go with your discretion. I would rather see you spend money to save lives. The rig should be assessed by someone to see what it's true value is.

Ron Sheltry - Our insurance will go over the rig and what is in it. The Department is going good. We have answered all calls on the first tone.

Chairman St.Cyr - Keep in mind we want to have an open house when the rig is ready.

Ron Sheltry - We are looking into spray foaming the outside of the fire station and siding.

Shaw St.Cyr - all is good.

Bob Wentworth. Will start cleaning the gravel pit at Lambert's. Will be on vacation next week.

Bob Wentworth - FEMA work going well. The loader is not waxed. The paving is 3/4's done. The loader will be waxed by next week. The trucks are all good.

Chairman St.Cyr - That should have been all added with the contract. Not now.

Cost will be split with the contractor and the town. Gate - \$319, Hinges 4 - \$55 shipping - \$30
