

The Select Board held a meeting on Monday Aug. 20, 2012, at the Dalton Municipal Building

PRESENT: Select Board Members Victor St.Cyr, Kevin Whittum Sr, Julia Simonds

Chief Sheltry - There is an EMTB class in Gorham and Dalton will be a satellite location. The course is 160 hours. The course begins on 9/11/12 and will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays and some Saturdays. We would like to be able to use a room in this building.

Select Board - have no problem with the course being held here.

Bruce Walsh - A dog attacked a hen on Bridge Hill Rd. The owners of the dog were warned to keep the dog leashed or they would receive an abatement. Things are going good at the transfer station.

Sandy York - Every year The Mercier Group does a financial audit for the town, we also have a worker's comp audit and a motor vehicle audit.

Select Board Member Simonds - questioned if there were any guidelines in place if everyone who works here walked out.

Chairman St.Cyr - MRI can come in and work for us.

Chief Audit requested the Board go into executive session for a personnel issue.
