

Procedure for Recommendation and Appointment to the Dalton Conservation Commission

The Dalton Conservation Commission (DCC) may consist of a total of seven members; five regular members and two alternate members. Terms are on a three year rotation ending in the month of January. The DCC recommends interested individuals and the selectboard is charged with appointing members.

Individuals interested in serving on the DCC must be Dalton residents and attend three consecutive DCC meetings before the commission considers recommendation.

Upon recommendation by the commission, the individuals must present a letter of interest and qualifications to the selectboard for appointment.

Any member with unexcused absence for nonattendance of three consecutive DCC meetings will be asked to step down as a member of the commission.
