

# Dalton Select Board Meeting

## Minutes of March 14, 2016

Present were Selectmen: Jay McCusker, Kathy Barden, and Nancy McVetty, Selectboard Chairman.

Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM

The minutes from the February 29, 2016 meeting were read. Jay McCusker moved to accept the minutes as written. Kathy Barden seconded the motion. Approved (3, 0)

The Library has asked permission to place the large sign from the old library above their windows as the information on the town sign is not easy to read. The Board approved this.

There is a vacancy on the Library Trustee board and they are recommending that Frank Tillotson, Jr. be appointed until the March 2017 town meeting. Nancy McVetty moved to accept the recommendation, Jay McCusker seconded the motion. Approved (3, 0)

The sink repair was discussed. There are two estimates, only one will work as a gray water tank was not approved by the State. The plan is to go around the back of the building and hook into the current septic system at a cost of \$3860. There is a possibility of pumping over the building using a special pump but that may be cost prohibitive. Quotes will be obtained before a decision is made.

The roof repair is a priority and may take any money appropriated for the building. A roofing company will need to be consulted.

Light repair at the front door and in the library will be addressed by an electrician this week. The electrician will also be looking at the pump station panel.

The mowing ad will be going to the papers this week.

The hazard mitigation plan was discussed. Mapping Solutions will be consulted regarding the preparation of the plan and the cost. There is a match from Homeland Security which will decrease the cost.

The sign for the old town hall was about \$172. Jay McCusker moved to move forward with the sign. Nancy McVetty seconded. Approved (3, 0). Jay will contact him.

Liability insurance is still pending. Two quotes will be coming from Hadlock and the other company in Littleton. GM Stevens will be contacted again. A decision will be made within the next month.

The abatement issue is in the assessor's hands, he will be researching it and making his recommendation prior to the deadline.

The State Fire Marshall office sent a letter telling the Town not to allow bounce houses. Inspections are required as well as liability insurance for their use in public areas.

Ed Craxton spoke about the Conservation Commission meeting scheduled for 6:30 Tuesday with the Northern Pass representatives.

There was a discussion regarding the municipal airport agreement. The Board will be doing some additional research before making any changes to the town's representative.

The Board adjourned to executive session at 7:15 pm
