

Dalton Select Board Meeting

Minutes of 4/27/15

Present were Selectmen: Jay McCusker, Kathy Barden and Nancy McVetty, Selectboard Chairman.

Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM

The minutes from the April 13, 2015 meeting were read. Nancy McVetty moved to accept the minutes as written. Kathy Barden seconded the motion. The selectboard approved the minutes of the April 13, 2015 meeting (3, 0).

Ron Sheltry reported that the ELP is done and needs to be signed and returned. Printed copies will be forwarded after the signatures are returned.

Both the fire and police departments are in compliance with the disaster program.

There is a meeting on 5/4/15 in Lancaster regarding the communication plan. Ron will be attending. Nancy and Kathy indicated that they would also plan to attend.

Ron needs to replace his laptop. He is researching prices and the cost will come from the Fire Department budget. Ron is looking at a wireless modem so he can use the internet from any location. The cost is \$40 per unit. Selectboard felt that more information was needed, no discussion at this time.

John Tholl reported that the cameras were received and the hall cameras have been installed and are working. The selectboard camera is installed but he is still working on getting it up and running. John expects to have the problem solved shortly.

A former resident has emailed the cemetery sexton regarding a relative who passed away. She wants to purchase a plot to place a monument with the cremains of her uncle along with his wife's ashes which are buried elsewhere. The cemetery sexton has checked her records and there is no record of the wife's interment. Other relatives have indicated that the wife's remains might be buried with the husband's parents. She died in 1992 and the ashes were in a plastic bag in a cardboard box. The niece is asking for permission to dig in the parent's grave to look for the wife's ashes. The board believes that permission from all living relatives would be needed to exhume the ashes and since there is no head stone or proof of placement better information is needed from the relatives providing positive proof that the wife is buried with the husband's parents before approval can be granted.




