

Dalton Select Board Meeting

Minutes of April 13, 2015

Present were Selectmen: Jay McCusker, Kathy Barden and Nancy McVetty, Selectboard Chairman.

Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM

The minutes from the March 30, 2015 meeting were read. Kathy Barden moved to accept the minutes as written. Nancy McVetty seconded the motion. The selectboard approved the minutes of the March 30, 2015 meeting (3, 0).

Instituting direct deposit for all employee checks was discussed. This can be done through Quickbooks; the cost is \$1.45 per check. Currently there are 9-11 payroll checks issued each week. We would not be able to do direct deposit for the MV payments through Quickbooks but might be able to do a simple transfer at the bank from the Town account to the MV account as both are at the same bank. Carmen Menard will be meeting with Linda Greenwood and Louise Jordan soon and this matter can be addressed at that time.

Roof repairs in the gym are waiting on the weather.

Nancy McVetty mentioned the loss of State money due to budget cuts. John Tholl indicated that the cuts are not definite; the Senate may change what the House sent over.

The cruiser has been repaired. John has located the missing radio and it is at the PD. Replacement cameras have been ordered and are in route to the PD.

Ron Sheltry is the administrator for the Verizon cell phone account. He is taking care of removing one name and adding another. Selectboard signed a letter making the change. Highway is getting two new phones that are text/talk only and there is no charge for the upgrade. Ron had arranged for residents to obtain burn permits on line for a fee of \$3. The permitting company gets the fee and sends Ron an email so he has a list of permits. Permits are still available from Ron directly at no fee.

The rescue truck will be going back to Maine for some adjustments and will be gone for a few days. Ron is working on the ad for the support truck sale.

The ELP is done and will be emailed to the agency. They will write a plan for the town to approve. Information will be on a thumb drive and will be reviewed and updated annually.

Haley St. Cyr asked for permission to use the gym for Cal Ripken baseball practice three nights per week from 5:00 to 6:30 PM from 4/15 to 4/24/15. She will complete the request to use Town property and the request will be approved.

Shawn St. Cyr turned over a box of parts and returned his keys to the pump house. He also presented a letter requesting payment for the time he has performed his duties at the pump house which the selectboard marked as received. The request will be reviewed for payment consideration but is not a guarantee of payment in full.

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Christine Rouillard showed a picture of a sign from another town's cemetery preventing people from planting trees and shrubs without permission and wondered if a similar sign could be placed at the Dalton cemeteries.

Carol Sheltry asked if the selectboard would be interested in having the windows in the Municipal Building washed by a group of WMRHS students who are fulfilling their service requirement. Selectboard approved.


