

Select-Board Meeting: 04-22-2013

Attending meeting: Board members, Vic St. Cyr, Julia Simonds, Kathy Barden

Meeting called to order by Chairman, Vic St. Cyr at 5:30pm

Chairman Vic St Cyr opened the meeting by asking for citizens' concerns.

Jennifer Parker had questions and concerns in regards to the Police Department. She would like to know how complaints are being handled how things are followed up.

The Select-Board will meet with the Police Chief and investigate, and do a follow up on the matter.

Fire Chief Ron Sheltry reported to the Select-Board about the storm over the weekend. There were power outages in the area. No shelters had to be set up. The Road Crew did a very good job cleaning up the downed trees and keep roadways open.

Ron Sheltry and Bob Wentworth are working on a grant to get a generator installed at the Town garage. They have vendors quoting the scope of work and getting prices.

Questions came up about the web site and if hours for the Administrative Assistant are posted. They are and have been for some time now. The hours do not come up on the first page but are listed under contacts.

The Select-Board reviewed the well water test reports sent to the town. The Board would like to have the contact person updated.

Bob Wentworth gave a brief report on Transfer Station; there will be chipping of the brush pile at no cost to the Town. Paving estimates and work to be done on Harriman Road before paving can be done. The work is under FEMA extension and will need to be completed before July.

Town Clerk Jessie Wentworth had received an e-mail from Jamie Dow from Department of Revenue. Jamie would like to come and meet with the Select- Board, Town Clerk, Tax Collector and Administrative Assistant. Jessie will follow up with Jamie to confirm the day and time of meeting.

Primex Workers Compensation Insurance sent a letter to the Town with updated cost of Insurance. The Town is in a pool program and if costs are kept down the participants get a reduced price for the cost of insurance.

Mowing Bids were opened there are two vendors. The Board did not decide on the bids at this time they would like more information from the vendors before they select a vendor. The issue will be tabled until the next meeting.



Seconded by Kathy Barden.


