

The Board of Selectmen held a meeting on Tuesday Aug. 30, 2011, at the Dalton Municipal Building, Dalton, NH.

2. Chairman's Comments:

Chairman Crosby- We would like to have Mario organize the police department as soon as possible. After the contract is signed we will do a press release. We are happy to have you aboard.

Selectman Hardy - Your budget should reflect what the town needs.

Chairman Crosby - Spoke with Mike Poirier regarding help from FEMA for individual home owners. The computer for the highway department will be paid for in time.

Selectman Hardy - The communications with FEMA have not been good.

Selectman St.Cyr - Reggie Rodger has retired. We need to post his job in the paper. Bob Wentworth said the culvert on Briggs Rd failed in the storm. He believes the problem has been corrected. Central paving will be here sometime next week. He will address any complaints he receives. Bob would like to apply for the hazardous mitigation funds to be used on McGinty Rd.

Chairman Crosby - Bob Wentworth does not need the baler at the transfer station so Selectman St.Cyr can barter with Mark Lufkin. It should be worth \$600 in scrap.

Selectman St.Cyr - Mark Lufkin helps us get rid of all our tires.
