

Dalton Select Board Meeting

Minutes of October 13, 2014

Present were Selectmen: Julia Simonds and Nancy McVetty, Selectboard Chairman.

Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM

Reading of the minutes from September, 29, 2014. Julia Simonds motioned to accept the minutes as written. Nancy McVetty seconded the motion. The selectboard approved the minutes of the September 29, 2014 meeting (2,0).

Ron Sheltry reported that the grant extension was approved. The rescue truck chassis is in shipment and the check is ready to go. When the chassis arrives, it needs to be registered and insured and shipped to Maine for the final work. Jay McCusker had a question regarding the dollar amount funded. Funding was provided by the Auxiliary with the balance needed to be taken from the Capital Reserve Fund. The sale of two other trucks will be used to offset the Capital Reserve amount. Ron confirmed that there will be a balance remaining in the Capital Reserve fund. Jay was clarifying whether or not additional funds would need to be requested at town meeting, they will not.

John Tholl reported that the Police Department had two messages from residents of Faraway Road regarding hunting dogs running on their property. This is not a police matter; the residents were referred to Fish and Game as they would handle the matter.

Cathy Fountain presented a letter from the Planning Board recommending Robert DeAngelis, a Dalton resident, as the Town of Dalton's representative to the North Country Council. He will replace William Howe. Ben Gaetjens-Olsen, Town Planner for the Town of Lancaster, provided a brief explanation of the value in having an active representative to advocate for the town. He also outlined what the membership fee affords the town regarding land use, economic development, review of the regulations, master plan, etc. North Country Council is not a governing board, they provide guidance only. As no appointment term is specified, the appointment will default to a four (4) year appointment. Nancy McVetty moved to accept the appointment, Julia Simonds seconded. Approved (2,0).

Cathy Fountain presented a bill for the NH Planning and Land Use Regulation handbook with CD at a cost of \$11.95 which will need to be ordered this week.

Nancy McVetty announced a notice received from North Country Council regarding three Transportation Feed Back Booth Sessions which will be held to allow residents to express transportation concerns. The nearest venue will be the Littleton Walmart on Sunday, October 19 from 10 am to 12 pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 pm.
