1. Meeting Minutes

2. Chairman's Comments:

Chairman Crosby - A decision needs to be made on the tax deferral.

Selectman St.Cyr - We should work with him and make a payment plan and let him know that he can get help with PSNH and other agencies. The deferral should not be approved but we should assist in any other way we can.

Selectmen - Will have Sandy York call him and work with him.

Chairman Crosby - Our attorney's office is willing to make a site visit at no charge. We should utilize this service and questions how can we enforce rules and regulations.

Selectmen - Agreed to utilize this service.

Chairman Crosby - We need to get the heat issue in this building resolved.

Selectman St.Cyr - Mr. Quigley should be scheduled to come in and meet with us.

Chairman Crosby - We need to get other opinions on what needs to be done.

Selectmen - Will have Sandy contact other contractors to come in and look at the issues and give us a proposal for fixing things.

Chairman Crosby - Would like to see us interview people who are coming up for re-appointments or anyone who would like to be a new member.

Vote: 2-0-0

Selectman St.Cyr - The road crew is working on grading between snow and rain storms. They are painting, welding and scraping the plows and a load will be taken from the transfer station to Littleton.

Selectmen - Signed a 3 year contract with Primex for that states the maximum increase can only be 8%.

Selectmen - Discussed Selectman Hardy had not signed the Time-Warner revised contract and Sandy should call him and check to see if he was coming in to sign it before the contract was mailed to Time-Warner.

2. Officers reports:

Sandy York - Lunenburg Fire District has increased our bill for sewage disposal. We need to decide what the amount of the new bill to our sewer users will be.

Selectmen - Discussed the issue and will come up with a definite figure before the next bill.

Sandy York - The ad is in the paper for cemetery bids.
