Annual Budget Hearing Minutes of January 22, 2018

Present were Selectmen: Jay McCusker and Nancy McVetty and Kathy Barden

Called to order 6:30 PM

Nancy McVetty read the 2018 Warrant Articles (copy attached)

A question arose about our usual "Pay Per Bag" warrant article we usually have to put aside money from the sales of bags to buy more bags.

Nancy explained we do not need to buy bags in the near future and that the Capital Reserve account for that purpose is well funded as of now.

Nancy then read down through the proposed budget line by line.

Nancy Smith inquired about the amount that the town proposed for the library. She spoke of monies that the library might raise throughout the year.

Nancy McVetty explained that the \$14570 proposed does include monies they may raise.

Christine Ordinetz inquired as to why we budget for a police department if we do not have a police officer.

Nancy read down through the breakdown of what costs were incurred by our police department and Jay clarified for Christine that we do have a police officer.

Christine also inquired about the town's loans. Nancy explained that the one we paid off in 2017 was a TAN, (tax anticipation note). It should have been a **very** short term loan, but a previous board got it turned into a longer term note. We have a loan left on our grader, but will be putting extra toward it now that the TAN loan is paid in the hopes of getting it paid off much sooner than the loan maturity date of 2021. We also have a loan on our backhoe. That will be paid off in 8 years.

Anna Gilbody asked about the \$3000 we paid on the Emergency Management line. Nancy explained that Dalton was obligated to update it's Hazardous Mitigation Plan and although it cost the town \$6000, (half was paid in 2016 and the other half in 2017), Homeland Security reimbursed the town the full amount so it did not cost any tax dollars. Just quite of a bit of time donated by several town officials.

Nancy asked if there were any further budget questions. There were not.
