In regards to the Covid-19 Virus:

Here is a list of some things the public can do to "Help Us Help You.":

- Wash your hands, cover your cough, don't touch your face.
- If you feel ill, self isolate.
- If you call 911, tell them of ANY flu like symptoms or recent travel.
- Call your Dr. (Do NOT rush to the ER for a cough)
- Inform EMS of any flu like symptoms ASAP after we arrive. We need to prepare appropriately.
- Do not get angry if our preparation takes time. We are doing it for the public's safety as well as our own.
- It is possible that Doctors will not want all patients transported to the hospital if symptoms are minor.

Keeping the hospitals from being overwhelmed is crucial. Please be understanding of this and don't panic.
