

Dalton Master Plan Update 2021

Share Your Thoughts on the Future of Dalton



Did you know the Dalton Planning Board launched an update to the town's master plan this August? The master plan was last reviewed in 2011 and it is due for an update. This fall the Planning Board will work with North Country Council Regional Planning Commission to reassess the town's vision and goals for the future.

What is a Master Plan:

A master plan is a set of statements and land use development principles that describe the best and most appropriate future development for the town of Dalton. The master plan can be used to establish a shared vision for the future, provide guidance to local decision makers, guide budget and capital improvement plans, increase access to grant funds, and set the stage for land use regulations if desired. The plan will look out 10 to 20 years into Dalton's future.

How to Get Involved:

The Dalton Planning Board seeks widespread input from residents, business owners, and all members of the community on the update the plan. Community members can provide feedback by attending any of three (3) "Days Out", through a survey, or by attending a Planning Board meeting.

Days Out: North Country Council's staff planners will set-up a booth at 3 community gathering spots to hear from residents and business owners. Come join us at:

- The <u>Dalton Transfer Station</u>, on Route 142, on Tuesday, August 24th from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM, or on Saturday, September 18th from to 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM
