Article 02 Operating budget

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand two Hundred Thirty Six Dollars (\$913,236) for the General Town Operations.

Article 03 Town Building CRF

To see if the Town of Dalton will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000.00 to be added to the Town Owned Buildings Improvement, Expansion and Renovation Capital Reserve Fund.

The Board of Selectmen recommends this warrant article. (Majority vote required.)

Article 04 Sewer Pump CRF

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to be added to the Sewer Pump Renovation and Replacement Capital Reserve Fund.

Article 05 Highway Dept CRF

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to be added to the Highway Department Heavy Equipment Capital Reserve Fund.

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Article 06 Paving CRF

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) to be added to the Paving

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to be added to the Fire Department Vehicle Equipment Capital Reserve Fund.

Article 11 Appropriate to the Fire Department Major Vehicle E

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Three Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Two Dollars (\$3,452) to be added to the Fire Department Vehicle Equipment Capital Reserve Fund, previously established. This sum to come from unassigned fund balance. This sum returns proceeds from the sale of the old Fire Department Tanker Truck to the corresponding CRF.

Article 12 Discontinue Police Cruiser Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the town will vote to discontinue the Police Cruiser Expendable Trust Fund created March 9, 1999, pursuant to RSA 35:16-a. Said Funds, with accumulated interest to date of withdrawal, are to be transferred to the municipality's unassigned fund balance.

The Select Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required)



Article 13 Transfer Police Cruiser Funds to the Technology CRF

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$22,751 to be deposited in the Technology Expendable Trust Fund, with said funds to come from unassigned fund balance. This amount represents the funds in the Police Cruiser Expendable Trust fund which was discontinued by Article 12, and this article is contingent upon Article 12 passing.
